Therapists who do assessments include Occupational Therapists (OTs), Physiotherapists (PTs) and Speech and Language therapists.




Complex equipment or housing solutions (e.g. adjustable beds, ramps and power wheelchairs) take longer to provide.

Solution

If funding is approved, basic equipment and modifications (e.g. shower stools or hand rails) are provided as soon as possible.

Clinical Advisory Service

Enable New Zealand's clinical advisory service works with therapists to find the most appropriate solution.



Dispatch

Most equipment is dispatched from one of our warehouses in Hamilton, Palmerston North and Christchurch. Sometimes it comes directly from our suppliers.

Trial

Your therapist may trial the equipment with you to make sure it works for you.
